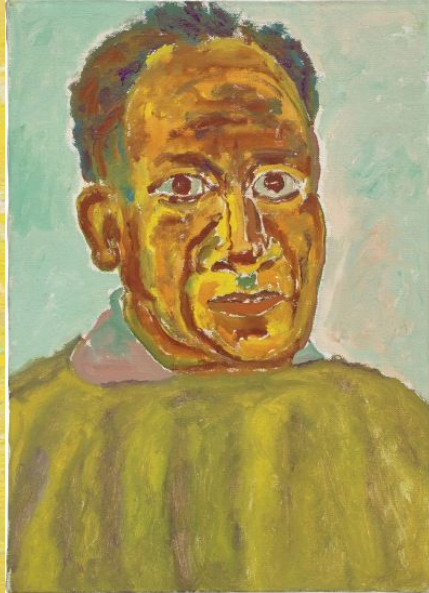
Beauford Delaney

Beauford started painting when he was a kid, and he learned his techniques from of an older, more famous artist.

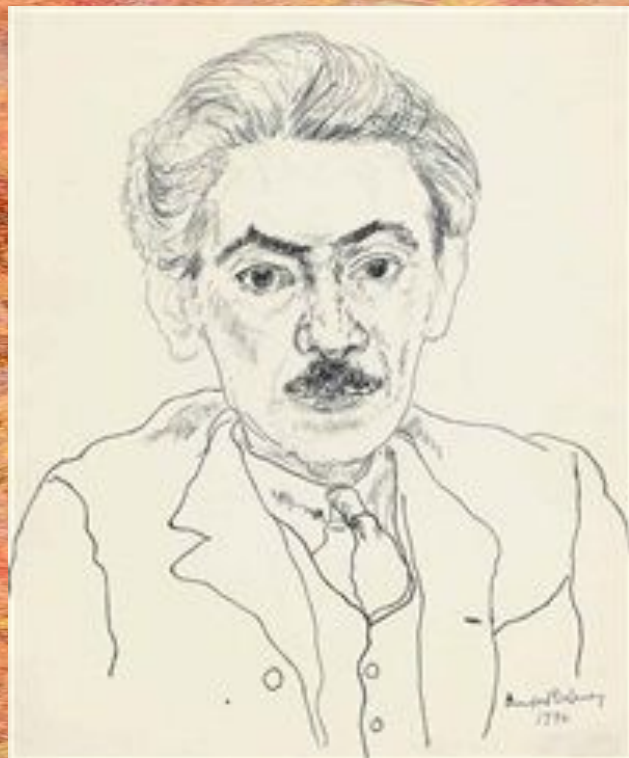

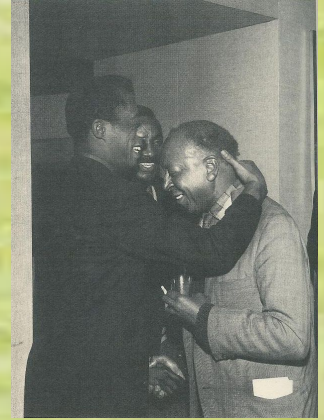
At the age of 53, Beauford moved to Paris!
